Admissions Policy

Introduction

Our nursery aims to provide a safe, stimulating, and nurturing environment for young children to learn and grow. Admissions Criteria

Age Eligibility:

- Children must be between the ages of 3 months to 5 years old to be considered for admission.

Priority of Admission:

- Disadvantaged Children or children with specific educational or developmental needs may be given priority, subject to the nursery's capacity to meet those needs effectively.

Application Process:

- Parents or careers must complete and submit an online application form, providing accurate and up-to-date information about the child and family.
- Applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to those who meet the criteria outlined in this policy.

Equal Opportunities:

- Our nursery is committed to promoting diversity and inclusion. We do not discriminate based on race, ethnicity, religion, gender, disability, or any other characteristic protected by law.

Enrolment Procedures

Confirmation of Placement:

- Upon successful application, parents will receive an email confirming placement and information about the settling in procedures.

Settling in sessions:

We aim to provide a supportive environment where children can feel comfortable and secure as they adjust to their new surroundings. Our settling-in sessions policy outlines the process for introducing new children to the nursery and ensuring a positive start to their journey with us.
