- The nursery is **closed on all bank holidays**, and regular charges still apply.
- **Refunds are not provided** for absences due to holidays or sickness.
- A **minimum booking of two days per week** is required.
- **Forest School attendance** incurs an additional fee of **£60 per month**.
- A **5% sibling discount** is applied to the **youngest child**.
- a **5% discount** is applied when attending **5 days**.

Funded Childcare

Government-Funded Childcare (Parent Entitlement Funding)

If your child is eligible for government-funded childcare, the number of funded hours your child receives depends on their age and eligibility.

For children aged 9 months to 2 years, funding is provided under the **Parent Entitlement Funding** scheme (for eligible working families). Up to 30 hours per week, maximum 1,140 hours per year.

For children aged 3–4 years, funding includes:

- **Universal entitlement : 15 hours per week (570 hours per year)**
- **Parent Entitlement Funding : up to an additional 15 hours per week.**
Maximum combined entitlement: **30 hours per week (1,140 hours per year).**

To ensure a consistent fee structure, funded hours are distributed evenly across the **51 weeks** that our nursery is open.

For example, if your child attends one full day (10 hours) per week during term time and qualifies for funding, their annual entitlement would be:

380 funded hours per year (10 hours × 38 term-time weeks).

This is then spread across 51 weeks, providing approximately **7.45 funded hours per week.**

To access the full 30 hours of funding (where eligible), a minimum attendance of three full days per week is required.

We offer a limited number of funded-only session places. Please contact us for availability.

Many parents may also qualify for **Tax-Free Childcare**, which can provide up to £2,000 per year per child towards childcare costs.
